Appendix A: Eligibility for Class 1 Inspection (Amnesty)

Female and gelded progeny of uninspected Irish Draught Mares by RID or Class 1 stallions or Section 1 S1 or Class 2 Stallions will be eligible for inspection for Class 1 status as follows:

- The **mare/gelding being presented under the amnesty** must be registered in the Irish Draught Horse Studbook in Canada and be sired by a stallion that is classified as CLASS 1 or RID or CLASS 2 or Section 1 – S1 in Canada or in any of the sister societies or in the studbook of origin, and out of a dam that is classified as ID in the Irish Draught Horse Studbook in Canada or in any of the sister societies or in the studbook of origin.
- The **dam of the mare/gelding being presented** must have a recorded pedigree showing her sire classified as CLASS 1 or RID or CLASS 2 or Section 1 – S1 in Canada or in any of the sister societies or in the studbook of origin and her dam classified as RID, CLASS 1, CLASS 2, AID or GRADE UP in the Irish Draught Horse Studbook in Canada or in any of the sister societies or in the studbook of origin.
- The progeny of Irish Draught Horse stallions of CLASS 3 or Section 2 – S2 or of uninspected CLASS 4 or ID status in the Irish Draught Studbook are not eligible under this amnesty.
